If your child arrives late it disrupts learning.



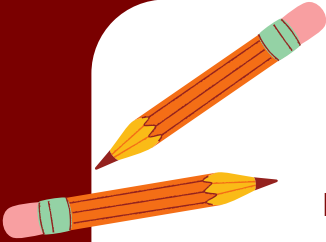
Our attendance target is 97%. If your attendance is at 90% -
